

Uniform Policy & Dress Code

Rationale

A uniform dress code reinforces in students a pride in their own appearance, instils recognition of themselves as an integral part of the school community, and assists in developing pride in representing their school. Issues of equality, health and safety, and expense are also factors that contribute to the establishment of the Dress Code.

Aims

- To promote equality amongst all students.
- To further develop a sense of pride in, and identification with our school.
- To provide durable clothing that is cost effective and practical for our school environment.
- To maintain and enhance the positive image of the school in the community.

Implementation

- The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms will be prescribed, and are required to be worn.
- The student Dress Code, including details of uniform items and places of purchase, will be published in the school newsletter at the start of each year.
- The School Advisory Board requires the Principal be responsible for the implementation of the Dress Code in a manner consistent with the Student Code of Conduct.
- Arrangements can be made to supply uniforms for families experiencing economic hardship through consultation with the Principal.
- Parents seeking exemptions to the Dress Code due to religious beliefs, ethnic or cultural background, student disability, health condition or economic hardship must apply in writing to the Principal.

Application of Dress Code

- The Dress Code applies during school hours, while travelling to and from school, and when students are
 on school excursions.
- Summer and winter uniforms, as well as sports uniforms are prescribed, and are required to be worn.
- Stud earrings and sleepers worn in the ears, plus watches are the only acceptable jewellery.
- Extreme hair colours (eg. Green, pink or purple rinses) and/or extreme hairstyles (eg. Spikes or mohawks) are not permitted.
- Student's hair that is longer than shoulder length (male and female) must be tied up.

- Hair ties to be of school colours.
- Other than clear nail polish, cosmetics may not be worn at school.
- The only headwear that is acceptable is the school's SunSmart hat consistent with our SunSmart Policy. They must be worn outside in Terms 1 & 4. Hats are not to be worn inside.

Dress Code

During Term 1 & 4, summer uniform is to be worn. (Please note that there is a transition period of two weeks at the start of Term 4 that takes into consideration the changing of the seasons.)

GIRLS' SUMMER UNIFORM (alternative to the dress)

Short sleeve blue shirt
Navy school trousers or navy school shorts
Plain navy school socks (strictly no ankle socks)
School pullover with logo and/or
Navy soft shell jacket with logo
Shoes - all black lace up, T bar, boots or plain black runners with no logos
Navy blue hair ties
SunSmart School Hat

BOYS' SUMMER UNIFORM

Short sleeve blue shirt with logo
Navy school trousers or Navy school shorts
Navy school socks (strictly no ankle socks)
School pullover with logo and/or
Navy soft shell jacket with logo
Shoes - all black lace up, T bar, boots or plain black runners with no logos
Navy blue hair ties (if hair is longer than shoulder length)
SunSmart School Hat

During Term 2 & 3, winter uniform is to be worn. (Please note that there is a transition period of two weeks at the start of Term 2 and at the end of Term 3 that takes into consideration the changing of the seasons.)

SPORTS UNIFORM

(Boys & Girls) The sports uniform is only to be worn on days that the students are participating in Physical Education classes or designated sports events such as cross country.
