
Camel Rides


HANDSOME – The owner saw him being born in 2015 when he was training a wild camel for a friend . His mother come from the desert in the Northern Territory.



SID and BUDDY – were bought in 2013 as 6 month old babies from the same place Handsome's mum come from in the Northern Territory.


LITTLE FLYNN – is the smallest but second eldest. He was born on November 1st 2011 and is the owner's little mate.


